General Information

USEK Background and Mission

Background

USEK was founded in 1938 as an independent private Catholic institution, by the Lebanese Maronite Order (hereafter referred to as the “OLM”) who serves Higher education in monasteries since the 18th century. The University was founded before the first Lebanese Law of Higher Education promulgated in 1961, and by that date, the Lebanese State recognized USEK as a private Higher Education Institution in Lebanon, according to the Law of Higher Education in Lebanon. Since 1997, the university has adopted the North American credit system, in order to facilitate students’ credit transfer and recognition and to move toward an American Style institution.

Mission

Since its founding, USEK seeks, and in accordance with the Article 92 of the Constitutions of the OLM (ed. 2012) and the social teaching of the Catholic Church on universities, to contribute to the development of all its students through quality educational programs and research in various fields of study. By providing a high quality American-style education to its students, USEK intends to prepare future leaders for innovation, professional growth and life-long learning, in Lebanon, within the Middle East and throughout the world. USEK is committed to a faith-based educational development of its students rooted in the Catholic tradition whereby spiritual values and ethics as well as respect for cultural and religious pluralism are promoted.

Institutional Evaluation Program

In September 2009, USEK has completed an Institutional Evaluation Program conducted by the European Association of Universities (EUA) and became the first university in the Middle East that conducts such an evaluation program.



Evalag European Institutional Reaccreditation

The European Institutional Accreditation was initially granted to USEK in December 2012 for a five-year period and in June 2017, the Accreditation Commission of evalag officially reaccredited USEK, thus re-awarding the evalag international label for Institutional Accreditation for another five years until 2022.



MATRIX Accreditation for Student Support Services

USEK became the first university in Lebanon and the region to gain accreditation for its student support services, which aims to ensure its commitment to offer high quality services to its students for their welfare on campus, and ultimately for supporting them in their learning, career and life goals.

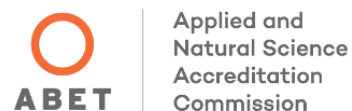

Architecture Program

The Holy Spirit University of Kaslik, Faculty of Fine and Applied Arts, Department of Architecture is currently in candidacy for the designation of Substantial Equivalency from the National Architectural Accreditation Board (NAAB) for the following professional degree program: **Master in Architecture**.

The program has successfully completed Visit One and Visit Two of the process. The final step is a comprehensive visit that will take place in 2019.

The term “substantial equivalency” identifies a program as comparable in educational outcomes in all significant aspects, and indicates that it provides an educational experience meeting acceptable standards, even though such program may differ in format or method of delivery. The designation is valid for six years beginning 1 January of the year in which the final visit (Visit 3) took place. In order to maintain the designation, the program must be visited again in the sixth year of the designation.

President



Father Professor Georges W. Hobeika, member of the Lebanese Maronite Order, became the President of the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik (USEK) in September 2016.

Father Professor Hobeika has held several leading academic and administrative positions. At the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik, he served as Dean of the Faculty of Philosophy and Humanities from 1992 till 2001. Between 2001 and 2010, he served as the Vice-President for Research and Francophone Affairs, the President of the Higher Research Centre as well as the President of the Doctoral College. As President of the USEK Construction Commission for 4 years (2002-2006), he oversaw all the site constructions and renovations held at the University. In 2010, Father Professor Hobeika was appointed as Vice-President for International

Affairs, and later in 2013 as the Deputy-President for Francophone International Affairs.

In 2011, Father Professor Hobeika received the award of the Insignia of Officer from the Order of Academic Palms by the French Government for his major academic contributions.

On the national level, from 2002 to date, Father Professor Hobeika has been serving as a member of the Equivalence Committee at the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education. Also, in 2018, Father Professor Hobeika was elected as representative of universities that practiced higher education more than 50 years, in the Higher Education Council of the Ministry of National Education and Higher Education.

On the international level, he is member of the Board of Directors of ACISE (International Catholic Association of Institutions of Education Sciences, and the Sectorial Group of the International Federation of Catholic Universities - IFCU), and a Member of the Board of UNIMED (Union of Mediterranean Universities) for which he was elected as Vice-President in 2018. He has contributed in several areas of studies and has lectured in philosophy, politics, education, ethics, religion, socio-economics. He is also a Visiting Professor and Lecturer in numerous countries including France, Italy, Germany, Poland, Chile, Argentina and Australia. He is fluent in four languages: Arabic, French, English and German.

Father Professor Hobeika was born in Meedane in the district of Jezzine in South Lebanon, but he also has French citizenship. He received his Ph.D. degree in German Philosophy with highest distinction from Paris-Sorbonne University in 1992. He took his first degree in Theology from the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik (USEK) in 1983. He is the author of several widely published books and articles.

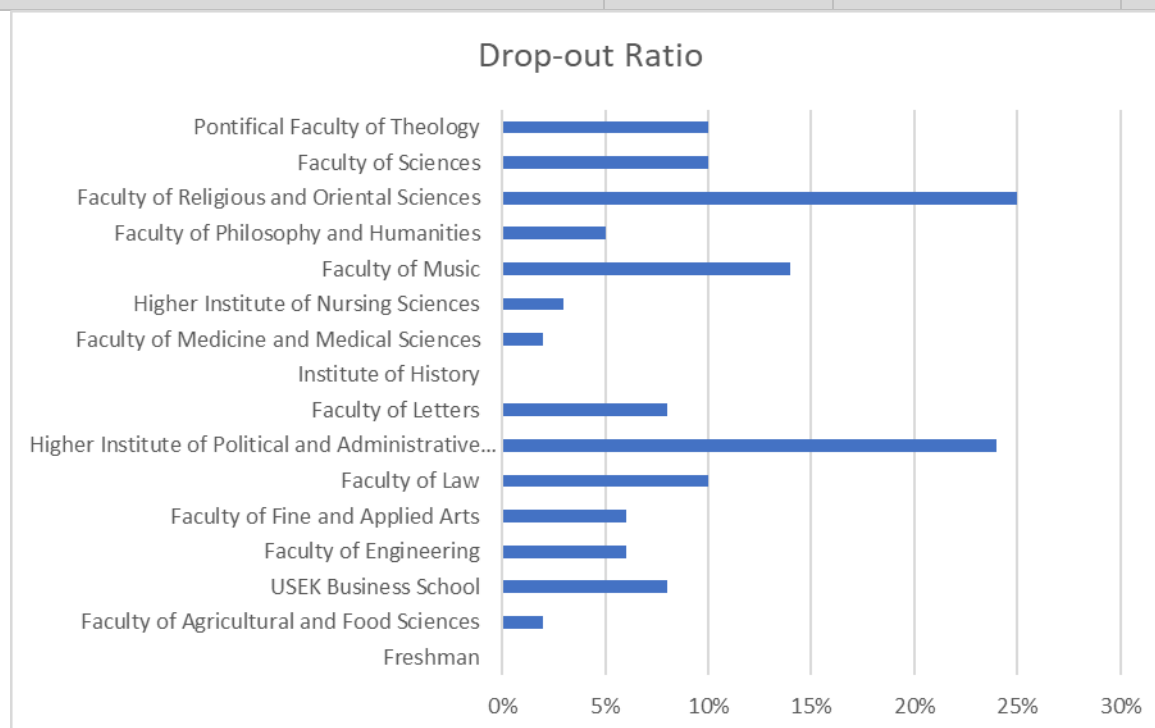

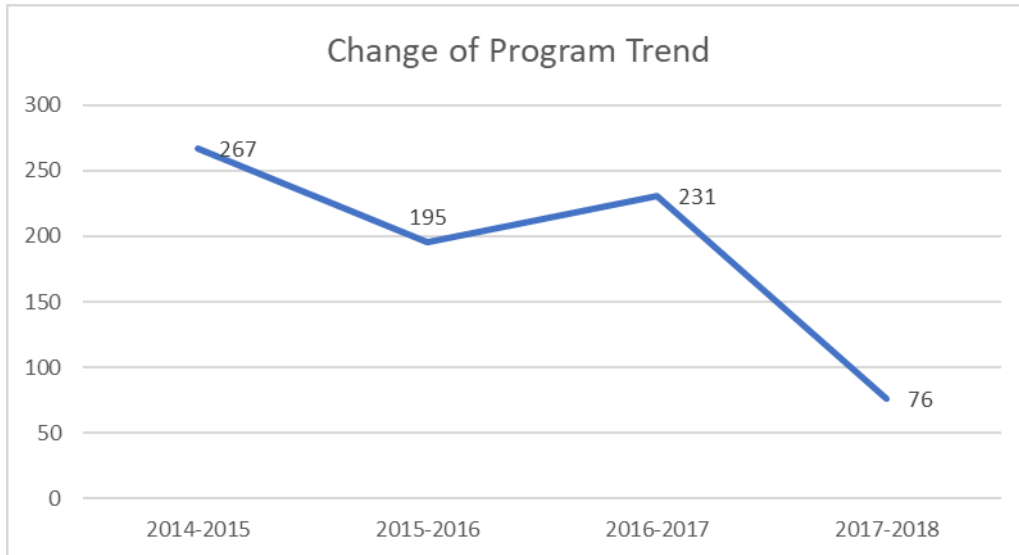

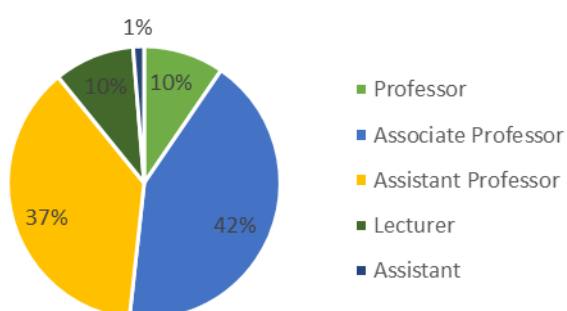

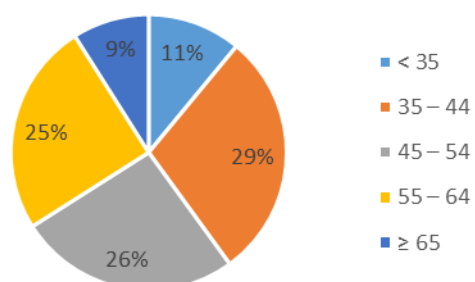
Distribution of Full-time Faculty Members by Rank

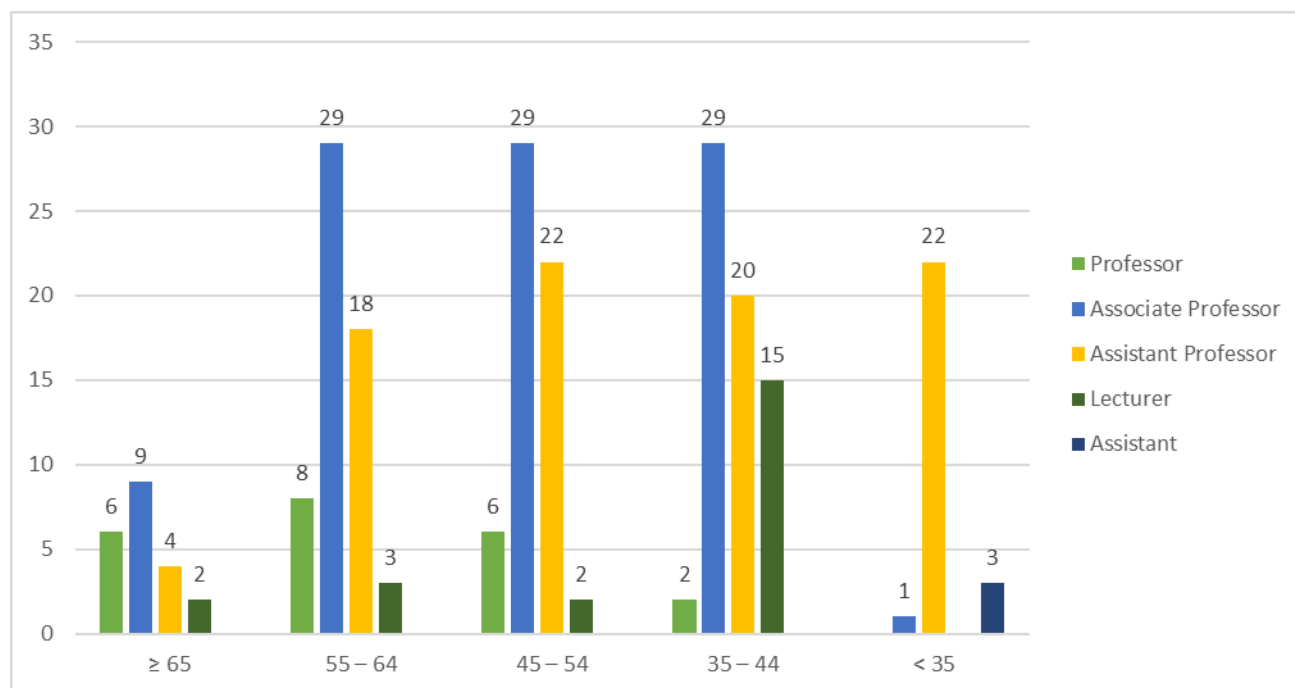


Full-time Faculty Members Age Distribution

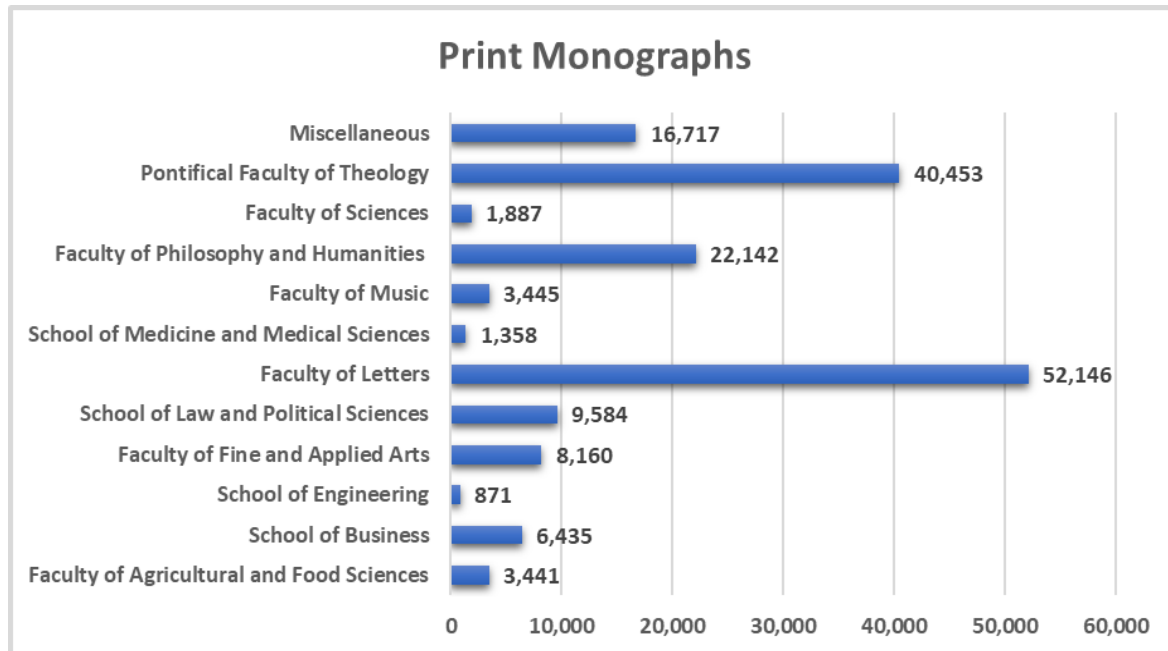

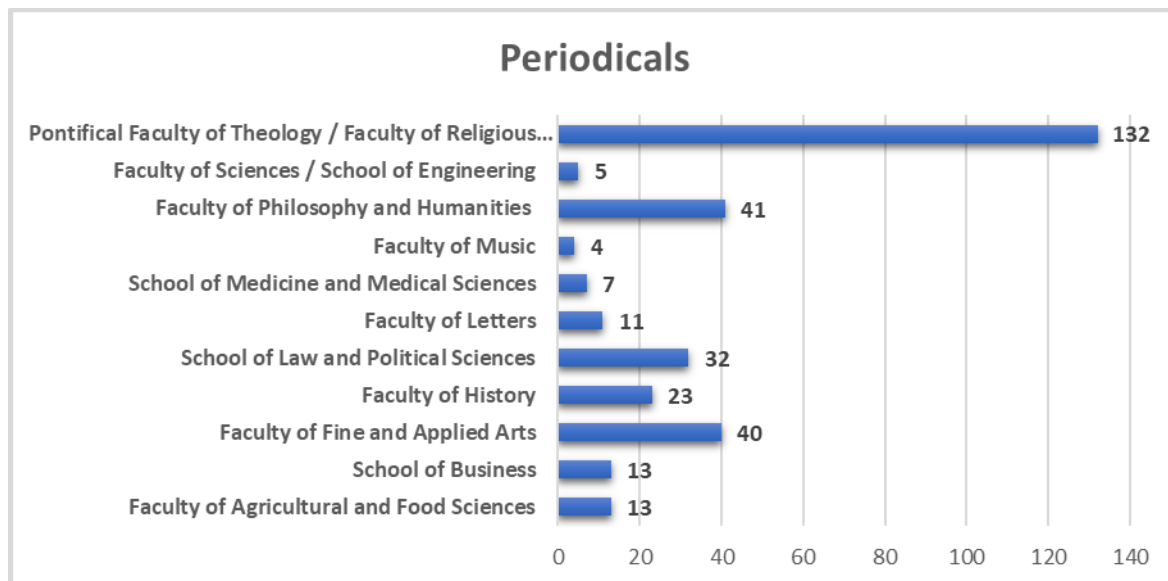

Print Periodicals by Unit

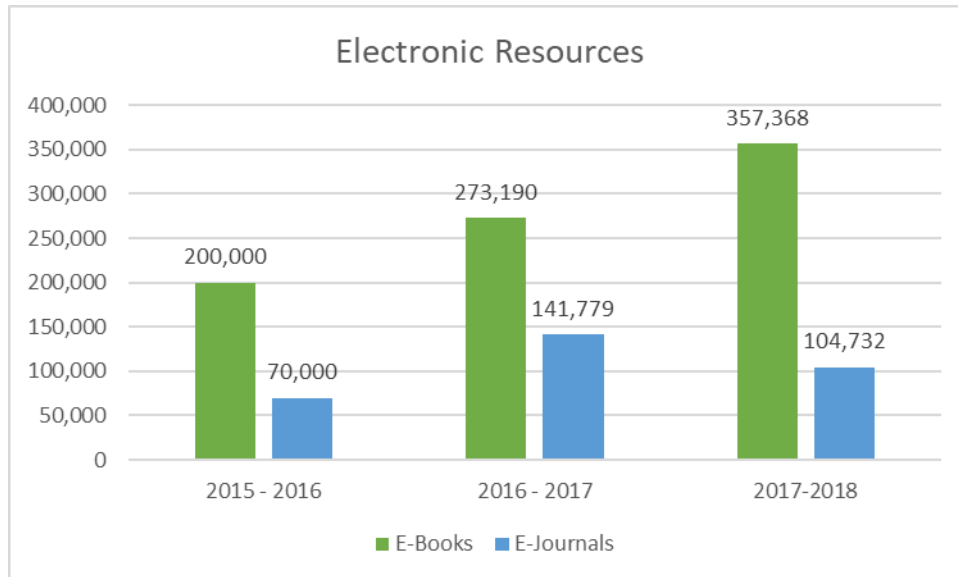

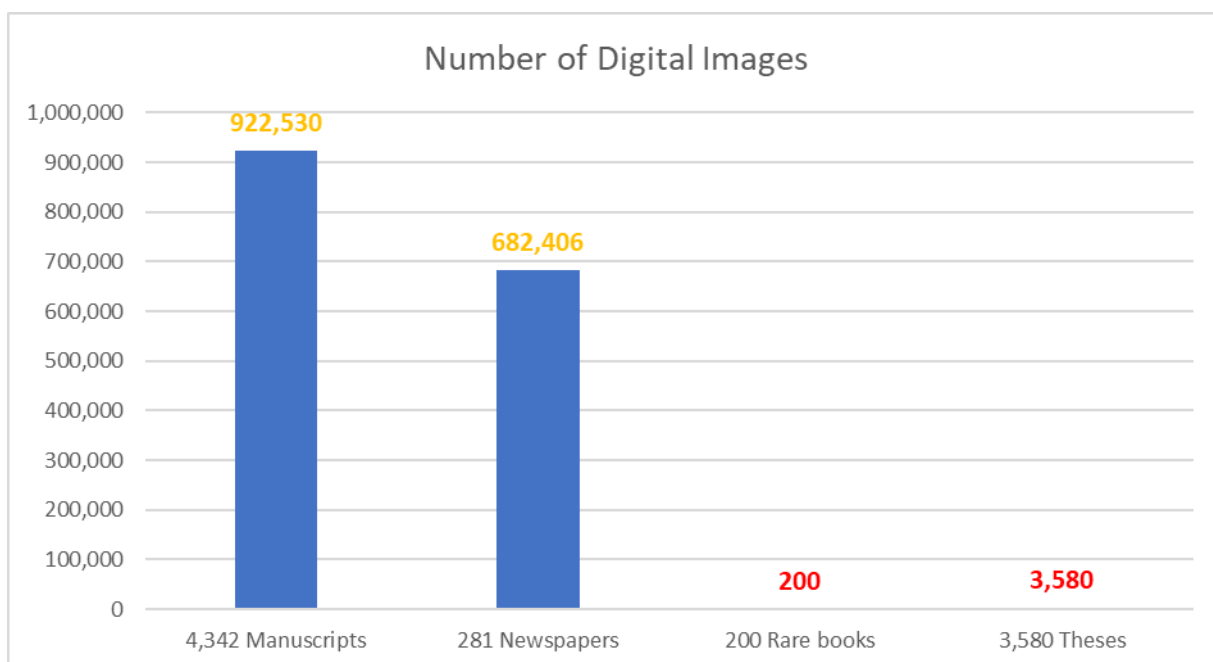

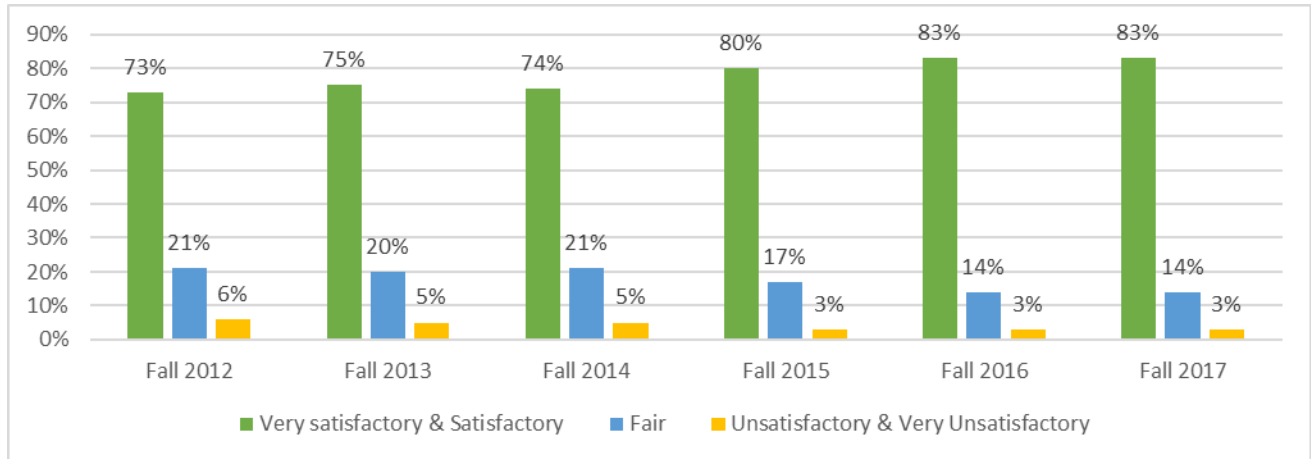

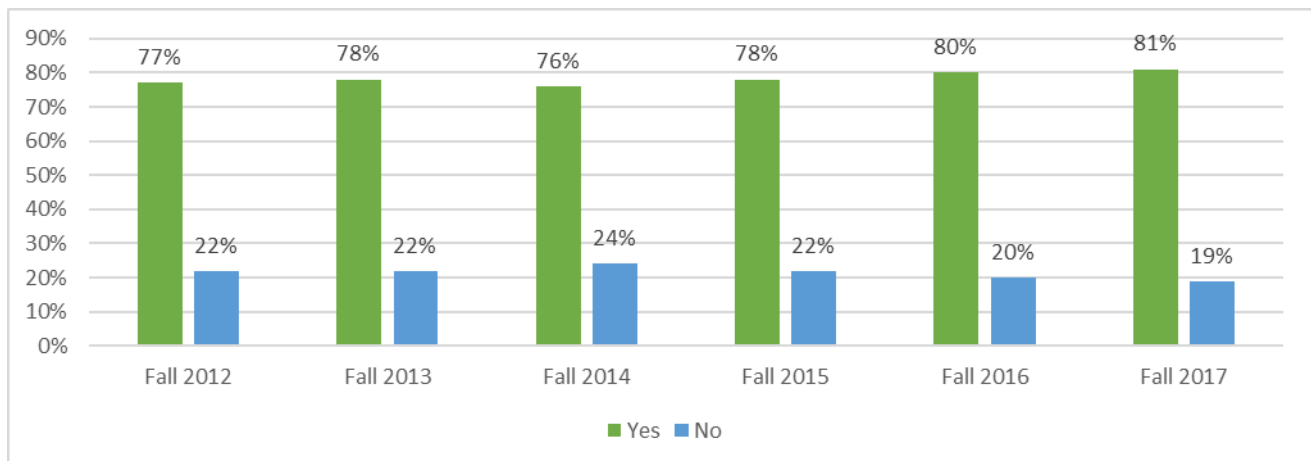
