USEK Background, Mission and Core Values

Background

USEK was founded in 1938 as an independent private Catholic institution, by the Lebanese Maronite Order (hereafter referred to as the “OLM”) who serves Higher education in monasteries since the 18th century. The University was founded before the first Lebanese Law of Higher Education promulgated in 1961, and by that date, the Lebanese State recognized USEK as a private Higher Education Institution in Lebanon, according to the Law of Higher Education in Lebanon. Since 1997, the university has adopted the North American credit system, in order to facilitate students’ credit transfer and recognition and to move toward an American Style institution.

Since its founding, USEK seeks, in accordance with the Article 92 of the *Constitutions of the OLM (ed. 2012)* and the social teaching of the Catholic Church on universities, to contribute to the development of all its students through quality educational programs and research in various fields of study. By providing a high quality American-style education to its students, USEK intends to prepare future leaders for innovation, professional growth and life-long learning, in Lebanon, within the Middle East and throughout the world. USEK is committed to a faith-based educational development of its students rooted in the Catholic tradition whereby spiritual values and ethics as well as respect for cultural and religious pluralism are promoted.

In September 2009, USEK has completed an Institutional Evaluation Program conducted by the European Association of Universities (EUA) and became the first university in the Middle East that conducts such an evaluation program.

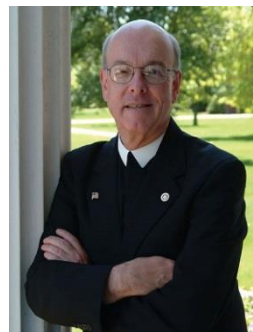

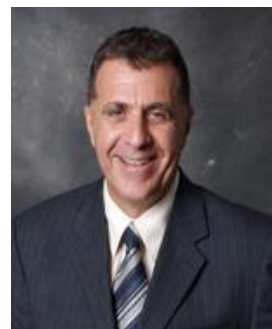

President



Hady J. Mahfouz (Fr.) became the 12th President of the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik (USEK) in July 2007. Since taking office, Father Mahfouz has been striving to implement a new vision in line with the tercentenary tradition of education, culture and community service promoted by the Lebanese Maronite Order of Monks, heir of the first school in Hawka – Lebanon (1623) and the first printing press in the Levant in Qozhaya - Lebanon (1610).

As president of the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik, Fr. Mahfouz has focused his efforts on comprehensive internationalization and consolidating pillars of excellence and quality at USEK. Within this scope, he has expanded the University international outreach and built new overseas partnerships while strengthening already existing ones. In order to promote excellence and provide a quality education, he has instigated a shift from teaching to learning in education, and has established a student-centered strategy.

He spares no effort to secure substantial funding for scientific research and academic programs, and to make USEK a hub of activity that meets the increasingly rigorous needs and requirements of the labor market and that promotes students' global competencies. He also increased financial aid to improve access to USEK for students of all economic backgrounds and enhanced excellence scholarships.

Father Mahfouz works fervently towards modernization, innovation and constructive change. He considers diversity as a true source of enrichment and prosperity. For that reason, he aims to create an educational environment which produces multicultural leaders of tomorrow through a trilingual and culturally diversified university experience. He gives special attention to sustainable development and strives to transform USEK into a carbon neutral university.

In 2013, Fr. Mahfouz was elected as the President of the Conference of Rectors of the Middle East (CONFREMO) that brings together 46 Middle Eastern universities and promotes university regional collaboration. He serves on the Global Advisory Council of World Learning that promotes international development, education and exchanges, and that gathers educational, governmental, non-governmental, civil society and private sector leaders from various countries in Asia, Africa, Europe, and the Americas. He also serves on the board of the Union of the Mediterranean Universities.

Father Mahfouz came to the Presidency after holding the positions of Academic Secretary of the Pontifical Faculty of Theology, Chairperson of the Graduate Program at the Pontifical Faculty of Theology, Director of the University Theological Periodical, and Director of the Financial Aid Office.

He was awarded his PhD in Biblical Sciences from the Pontifical Biblical Institute of Rome in 2002. He has lectured and published widely and is the author of several books.

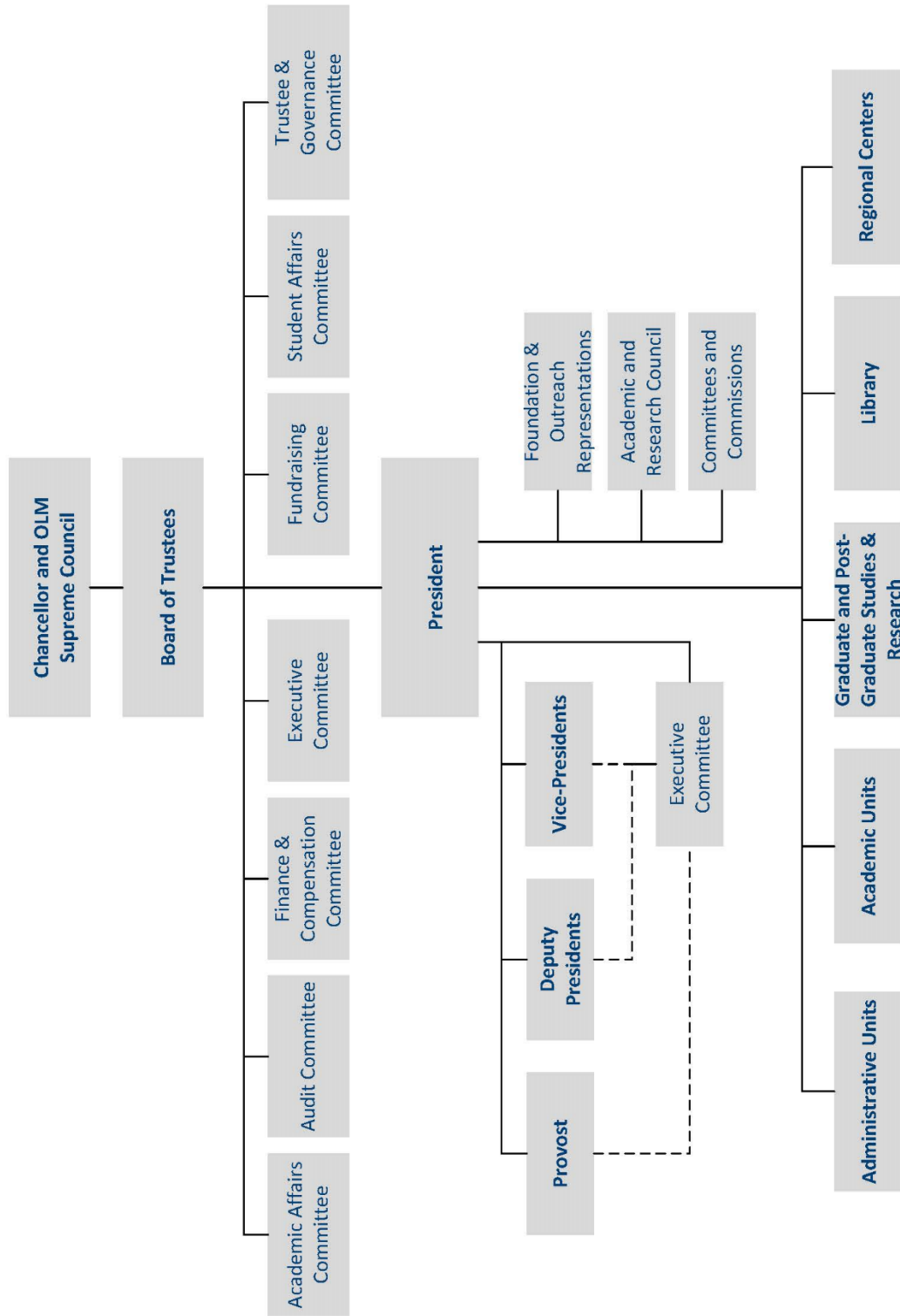

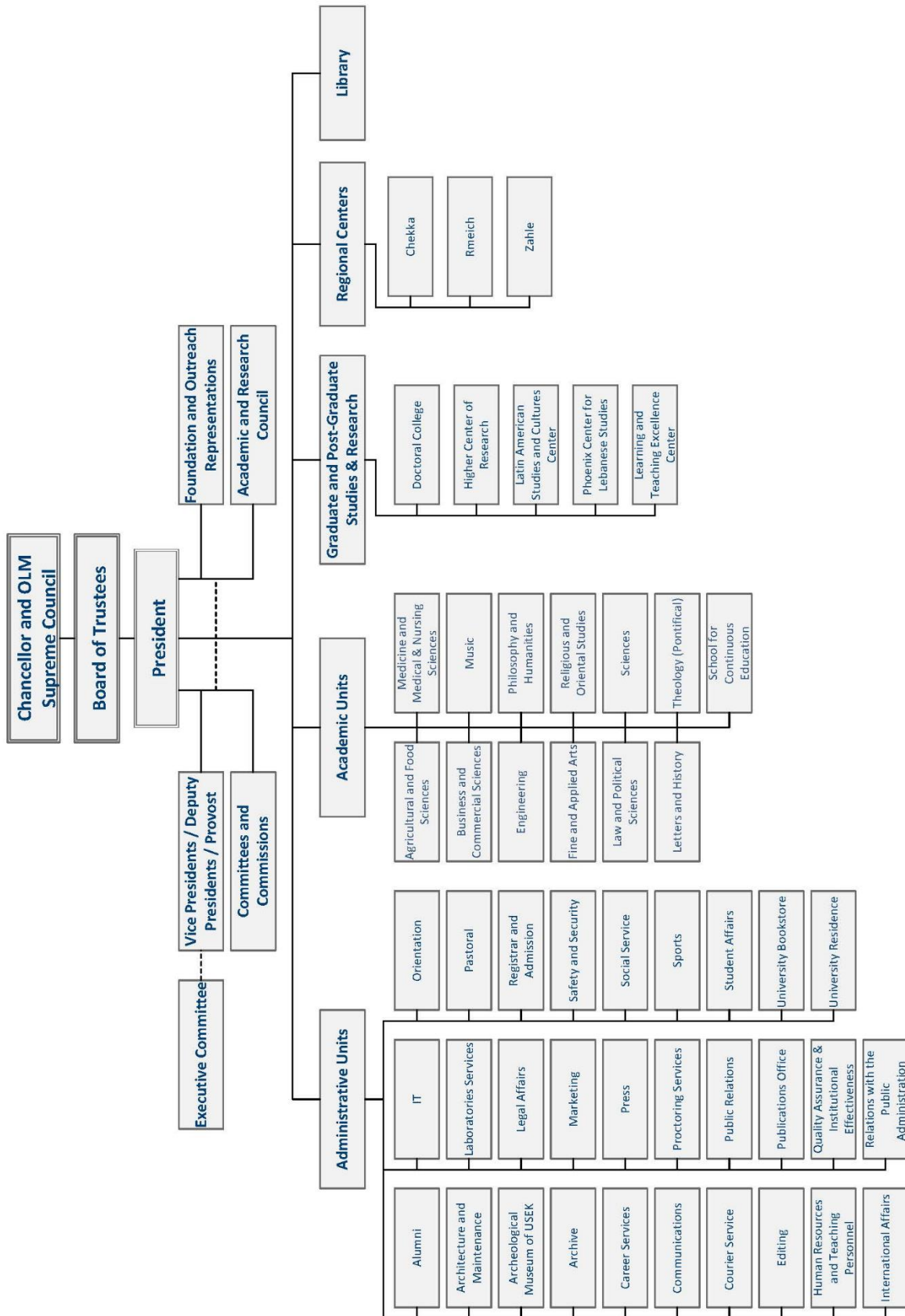

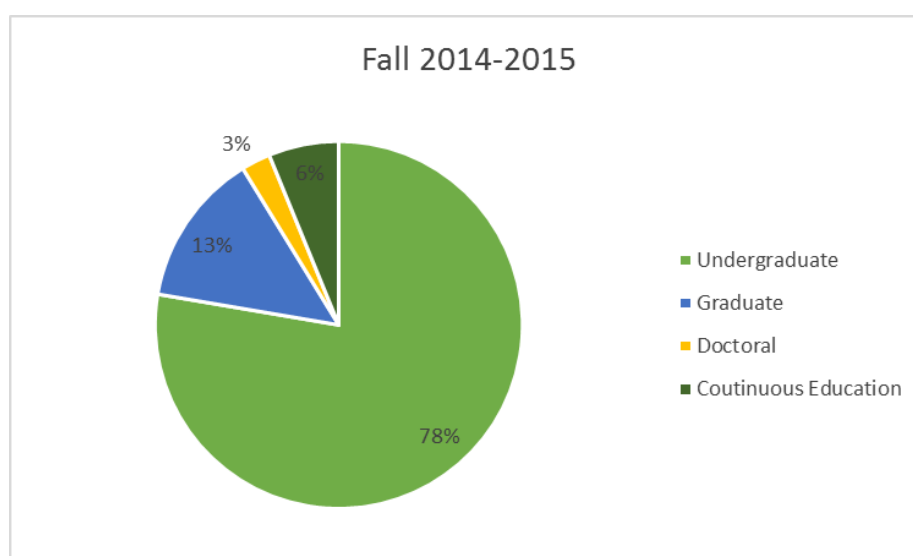

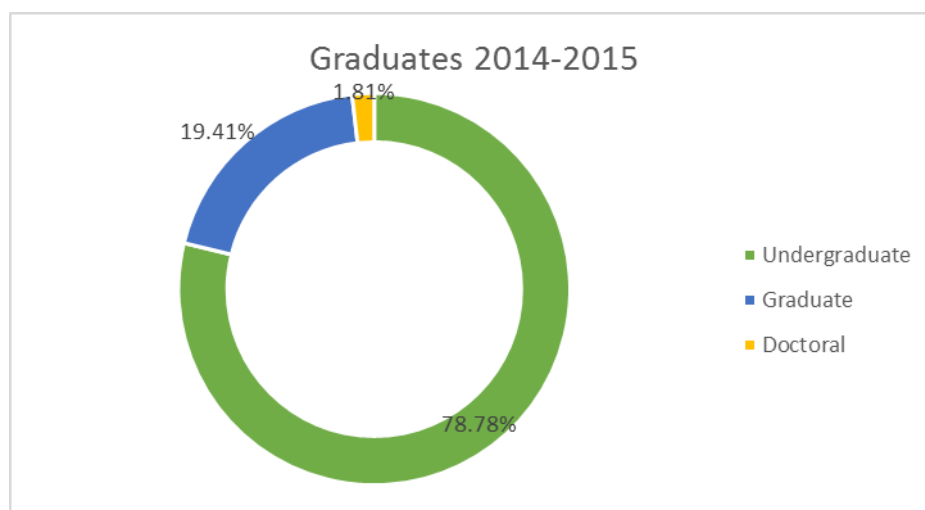

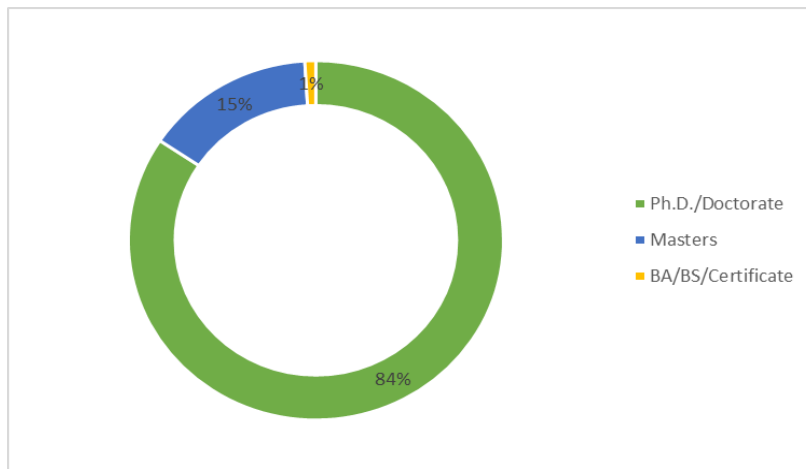

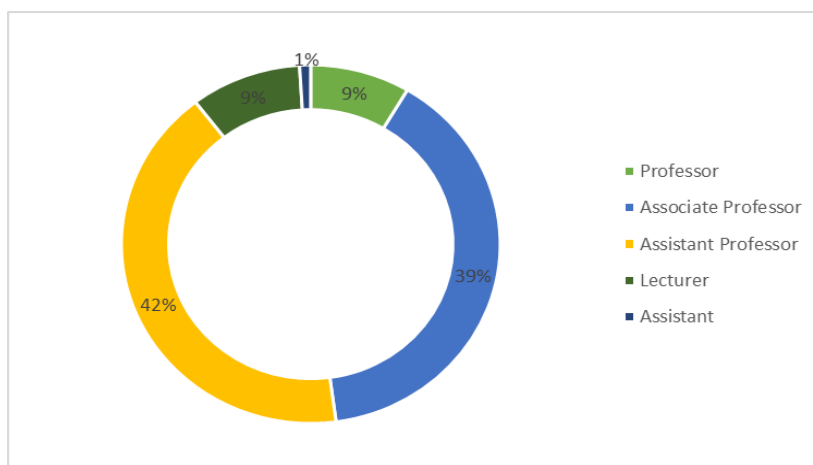
Distribution of Full-time Faculty Members by Degree

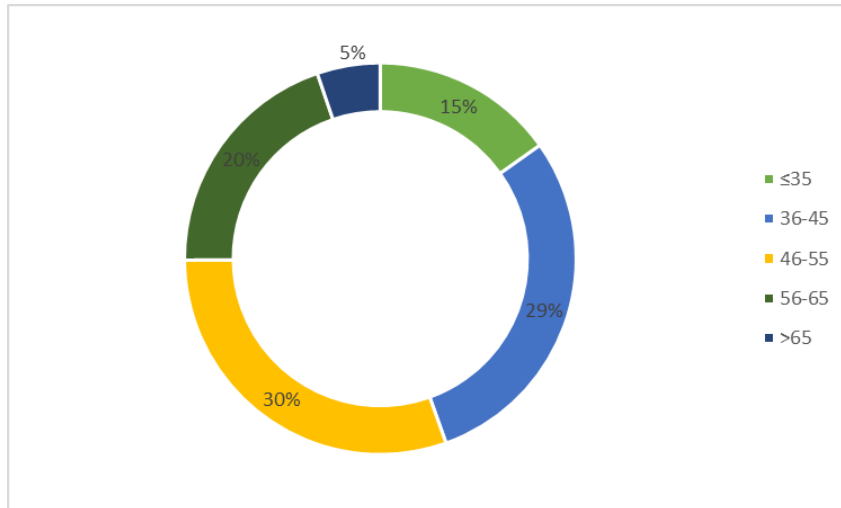
Distribution of Full-time Faculty Members by Rank

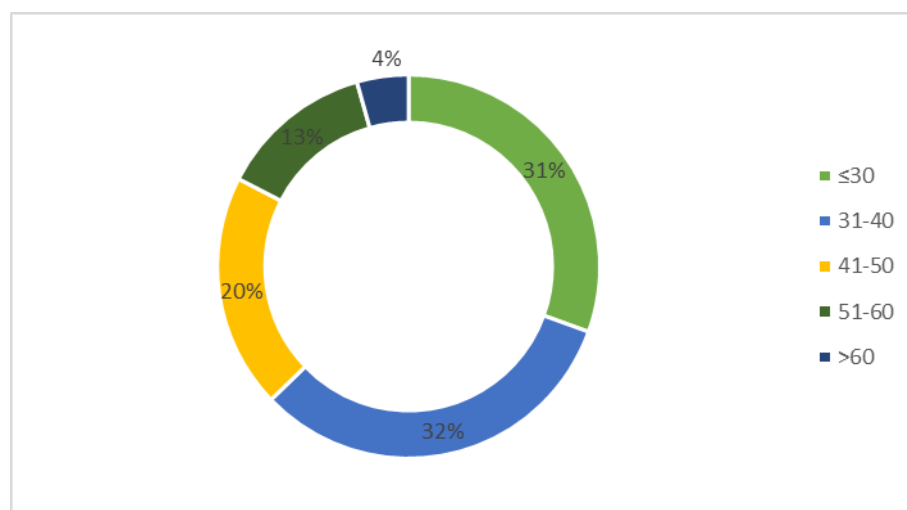

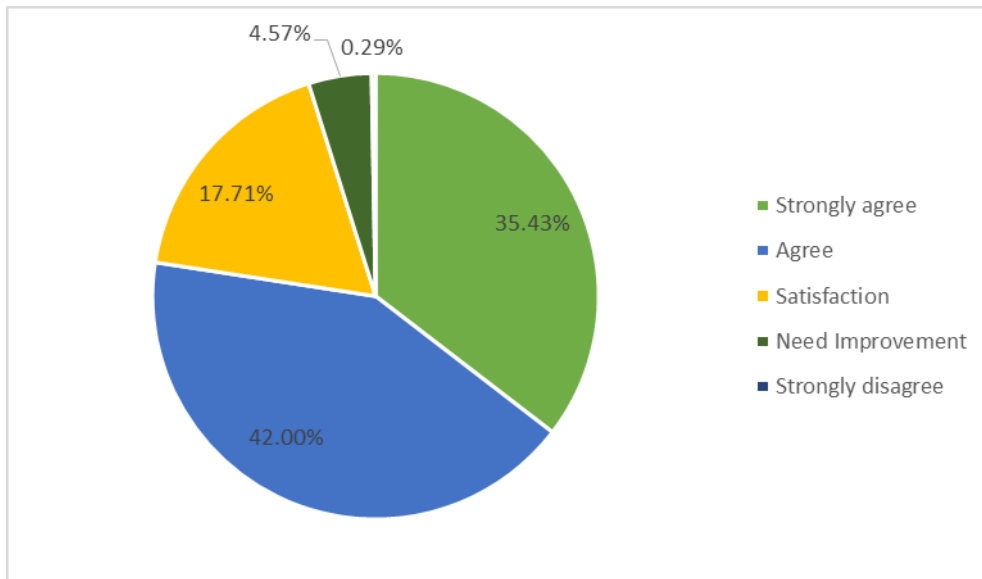

Course Self-Assessment by Faculty - Fall 2014-2015

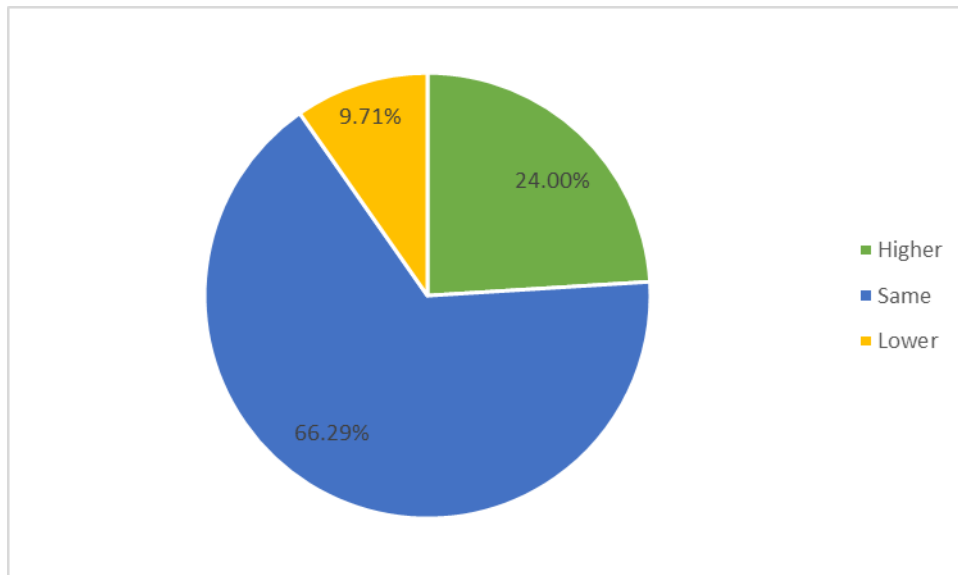
- Did the students demonstrate achievement of the desired educational outcomes that you, as instructor, hoped to cover?

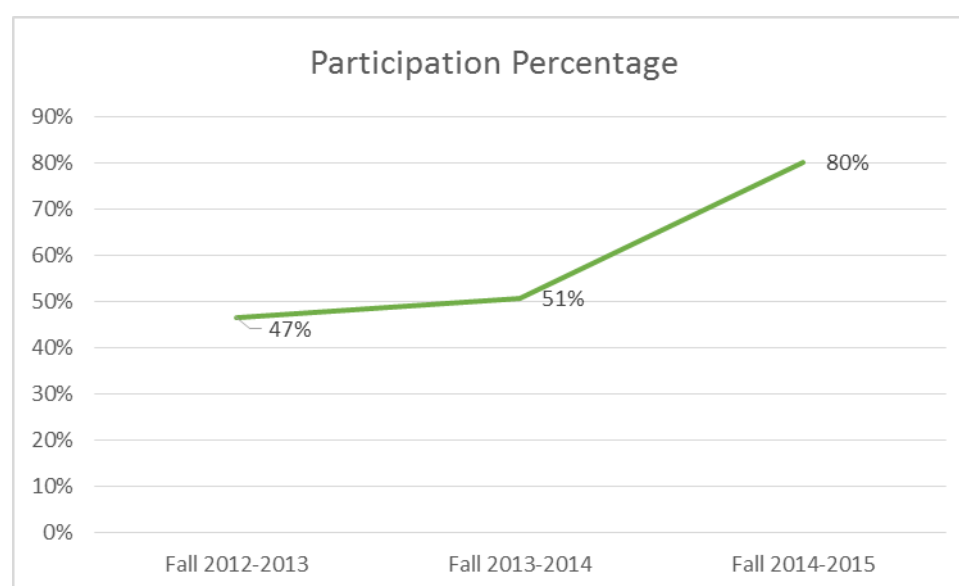

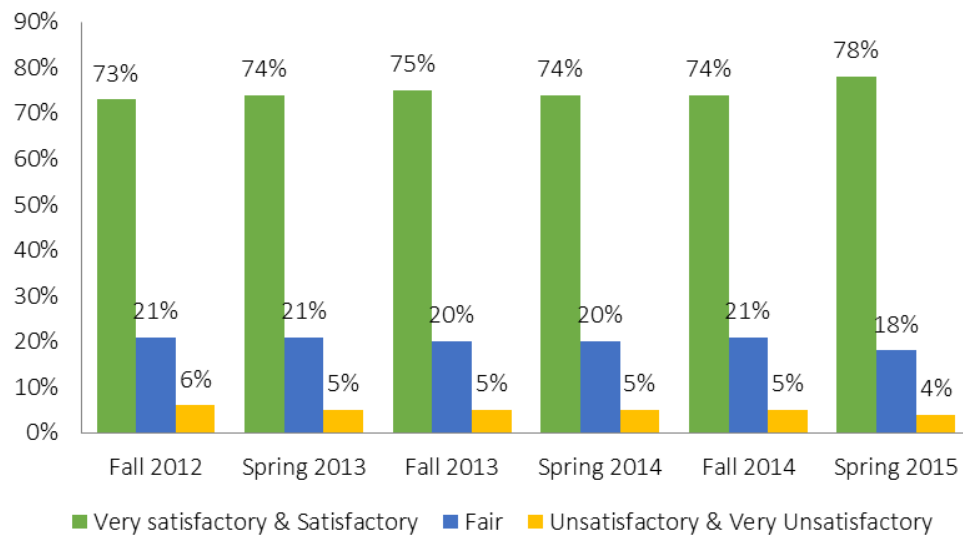

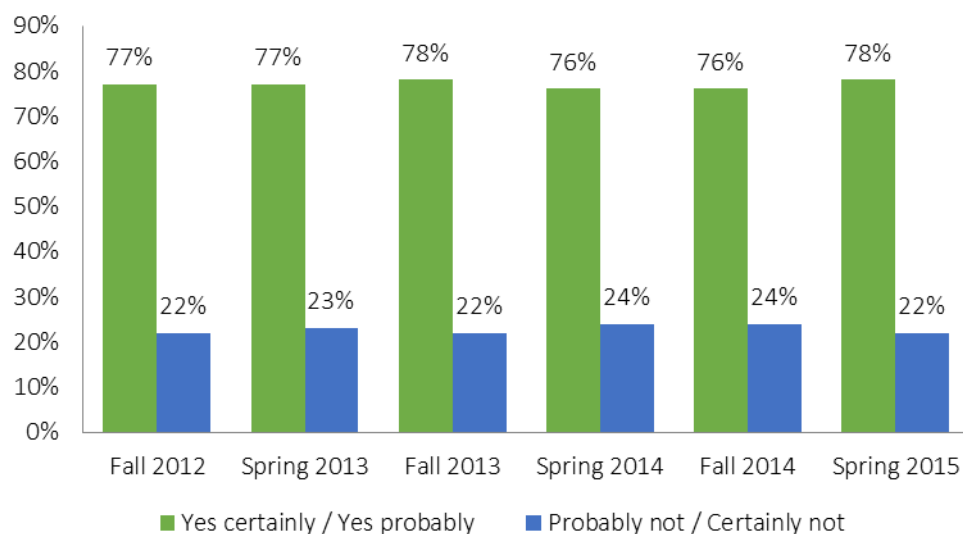
