# **ONLINE WORLD**

As students; our parents were not all enrolled in universities. As students; our parents pay tens of thousands of dollars for our education. As parents; we do pay and will pay tens of thousands of dollars for our children's education. As parents; our children will not continue and will not accept to pay tens of thousands of dollars for what the online world can give them for free. The online world destroyed traditional business, traditional stock traders, traditional sales and traditional banks! It will destroy traditional universities!
