MOU BETWEEN USEK AND THE NEW JERSEY INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

In the frame of University cooperation, a Memorandum of Understanding was signed between the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik (Lebanon) and the New Jersey Institute of Technology (USA) represented by Fadi P. Deek, Ph.D., Provost and senior Executive Vice President of NIJT on the 6th of June 2016. The purpose of this MoU is to establish and advance academic exchange and cooperation in the general field of Science.

Furthermore, the participating institutions plan to collaborate in the development of several joint Master-level degrees in Science (including Computer Science) and Engineering (Ms) starting with a MSMCF [Master ofScience in Mathematical and Computational Finance (NJIT) / Master ofScience in Actuarial & Financial Mathematic (USEK)] and a MSCSC [Master of Science in Computer Science (NJIT) / Master of Science inComputer Science (USEK)]. Consequently, students participating in such an MS Program will earn one degree from USEK and one degree from NJIT by completing at least 30 course credits and at least 6 credits of thesis. Some of the main goals of this cooperation between the two institutions are: to develop an institutional basis for cooperation and exchanges, to develop Master of Science degree programs that would advance the expertise and competences of participating students to increase employment opportunities, to improve the proficiency of

students in foreign language(s) and their appreciation of multiple cultures, in addition to facilitate the operation of participating students and faculty members in different international environments.
