THE CHADIRJI AWARDS

The Chadirji Awards is an honorary award supervised by the Chadirji Foundation under the presidency of Mr. Leon Telvizian and hosted by the Lebanese Order of Engineers and Architects in Beirut. It is aimed at architecture students who just finished their final year projects and graduated with distinction. The international jury's main criteria of selection focuses around the social aspects of architecture and how buildings can integrate this dimension. This is a criteria that is well integrated in USEK's principles as it has allowed our students to win the first and third place of the 16th Chadirji Awards edition for second consecutive year, out of 18 students from 8 different universities.

2015 first prize winner, Vanessa Houeiss – student of Mr. Alphonse Kai – observed that Beirut, is a diverse melting pot of various cultural, religious, political, and architectural traditions and styles built over and over again on its own ruins. Therefore her project consisted of a synthetic discovery in Beirut where she focused on occupying some of the few remaining empty plots with artistic and cultural functions. 2015 third prize winner, Alexandre Zein – also supervised by Mr. Alphonse Kai – attempted to tackle one of the issues related to Syrian refugees in Lebanon. Mr. Zein created a system which transforms informal settlements into well-organized shelter camps. This achievement could not have been realized without the vision, dedication, and supervision of the whole Faculty of Fine and Applied Arts.
