

Eduroam (**education roaming**) is a secure, world-wide roaming wireless access service developed for the international research and education community. It allows students, researchers and staff from participating institutions to visit other organizations and use the same username and password as they would use at their home institution.

Eduroam Network allows USEK users who are visiting an institution that is a member of Eduroam, to access their network using USEK credentials. Moreover, it allows USEK visitors, from other member institutions, to access our network using the credentials provided by their home institution.

More than 6,000 Eduroam hotspots are available at different universities, research centers, academies, many schools and other research and education institutions in more than 70 territories around the world. As Eduroam grows, more and more hotspots are appearing in additional places such as libraries, museums and public spaces such as railway stations and coffee shops.

How To access the service:

For visitors:

All visitors from participating institutions can use USEK's Eduroam secure wireless network by selecting the Eduroam wireless network (SSID) anywhere on USEK Campus. Users should use their home institution's username (email format: username@domain) and password to login to Eduroam.

For USEK users:

Members of the USEK community who visit another participating organization can connect to the wireless as follows:

- Choose the Eduroam SSID wireless network
- At username enter your USEK NetID email (e.g. ziadeid@usek.edu.lb)
- At password enter your USEK password.
