### ADMISSION

This Dual Degree is open to business and non-business applicants fulfilling the following criteria:

- Hold a Bachelor's degree in any major with a minimum GPA of 70/100;
- Pass the compulsory entrance exams of the USEK Business School (written and oral):
- Have a minimum of 79 on the TOEFL-IBT electronic version or to be in Band 6 on the IELTS unless candidates have finished their studies in an English high-school or university;
- Pass the oral interviews conducted by HEC Montréal and USEK jury members;
- Documents needed: USEK and HEC Montréal application forms available at the Admissions Office;
- Two letters of recommendation highlighting the applicant's academic and/or work experience;
- Curriculum Vitae.


