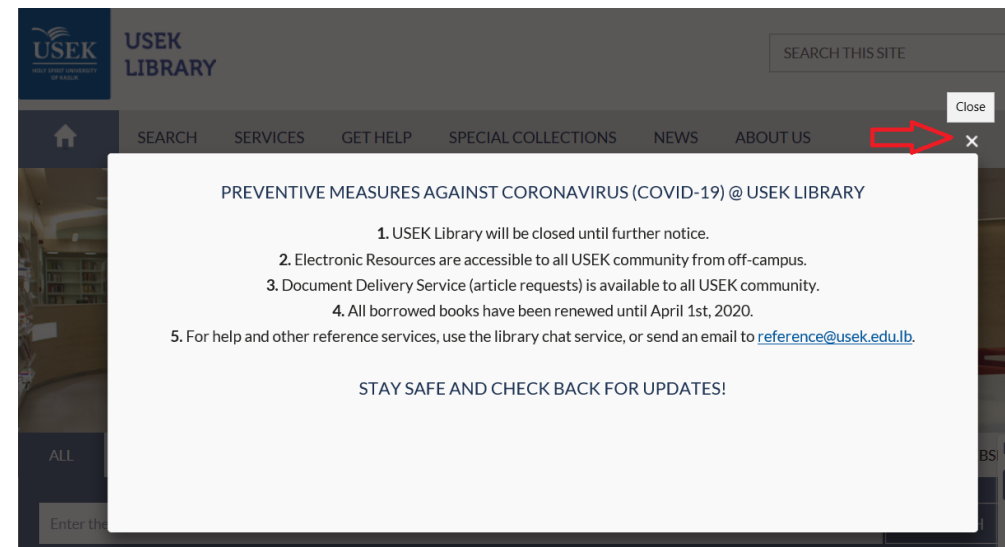

- A pop-up notification for the Library updates will appear; close it to start your search.

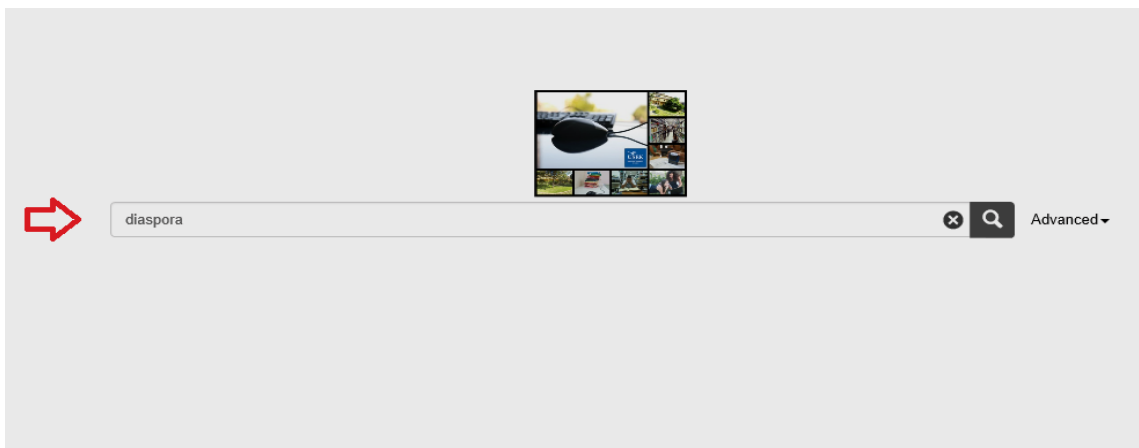

2 'ONE SEARCH' TOOL

- The **'One Search'** tool is a "Google-like solution".
- It provides content found in Library databases, Library collections, abstract and indexing resources, and Open Access collections.
- Click on the **'One Search'** tab, type your search term in the box, and click **'ENTER'**.
- We chose **'Diaspora'** as a keyword.



2 'ONE SEARCH' TOOL

- You will get a set of results with the keyword '**Diaspora**'.
- You can go through all of them to choose what you want or narrow down the search by using '**Refine your Search**' column to the left.

- After refining your search, click on the desired title.
