BACKGROUND / MISSION

Background

USEK was founded in 1938 as an independent private Catholic institution, by the

Lebanese Maronite Order (hereafter referred to as the "OLM") who have served higher education in monasteries since the 18th century. Preceding the first Lebanese Law of Higher Education, put into effect in 1961, USEK was officially certified as a private higher education institution under the new law in 1962. Since 1997, the University has adopted the North American credit system in a move toward an American-style institution to facilitate students' credit transfer and recognition locally and abroad.

Mission

Since its founding, USEK has sought to contribute to the development of all its students through quality educational programs and research in various fields of study. By providing a high-quality American-style education to its students, and in accordance with Article 92 of the Constitutions of the OLM (ed. 2012), and the social teaching of the Catholic Church in universities, USEK prepares future leaders for innovation, professional growth and life-long learning in Lebanon, within the Middle East, and throughout the world. USEK is committed to a faith-based educational development of its students rooted in the Catholic tradition whereby spiritual values and ethics as well as respect for cultural and religious pluralism are supported.



HISTORY

- 1938** Founding of the OLM institution, a one-building scholasticate (now Building A) where theology, philosophy, letters and canon law were taught and continue to be taught today.
- 1962** Following the enactment of the law of higher education in Lebanon, the scholasticate became the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik (USEK).
- 1997** Adoption of the North American credit system
- 2000** Founding of three Regional University Centers in the North (Chekka), South (Rmeich) and Bekaa (Zahle).
- 2012** Awarded evalag European institutional accreditation - renewed in 2017
- 2016** Awarded ABET accreditation for nine computing and engineering programs.
- 2017** Awarded evalag accreditation for the humanities and social sciences programs.
- 2018** Awarded ABET accreditation for two applied and natural sciences and the civil engineering programs.
- 2019** Implementation of the new academic structure: Faculty of Arts and Sciences, School of Architecture and Design, Business School, School of Engineering, School of Law and Political Sciences, School of Medicine and Medical Sciences, Pontifical School of Theology.

International Certification from the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) for the School of Architecture and Design for its Master in Architecture program.

Granting of a six-year full accreditation for the undergraduate Medical Education Program offered by the School of Medicine and Medical Sciences after successfully evaluation by the Association for Evaluation and Accreditation of Medical Education Programs (tepdad).

ACADEMIC UNITS

The University has recently restructured its academic units, replacing its twelve faculties and three institutes with one faculty and six schools. A new academic structure was implemented in fall, 2019.

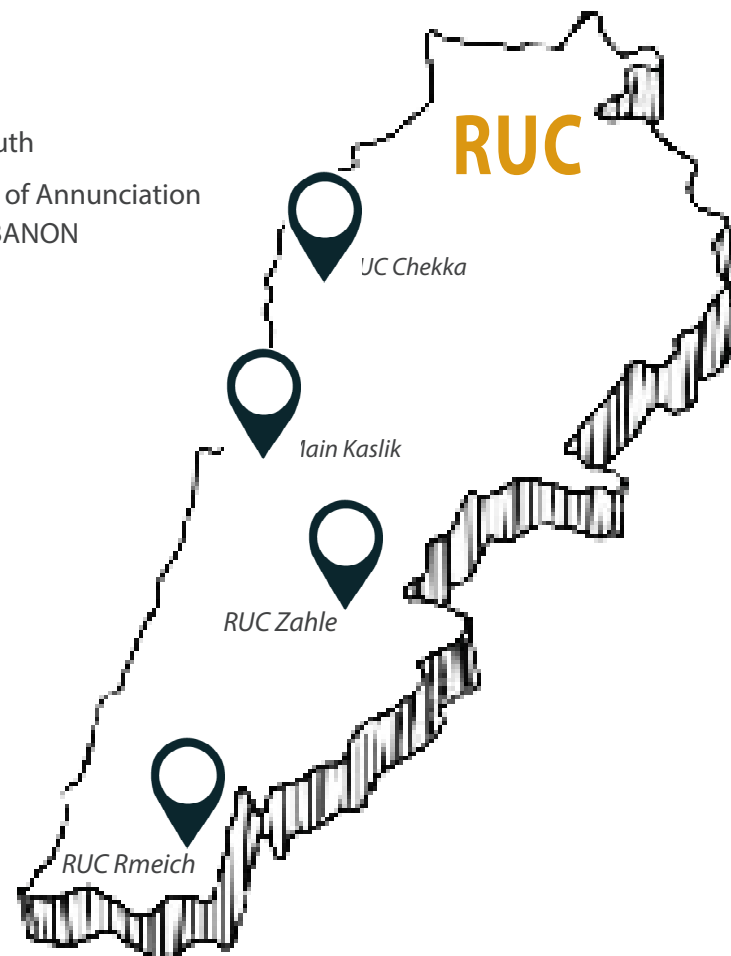

ACCREDITATIONS, EVALUATIONS, RANKINGS

NECHE Eligibility

In April 2021, The New England Commission of Higher Education has determined that the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik is eligible to proceed with an application for candidacy for accreditation within two years.



A determination of eligibility is not candidacy or accreditation, nor does it indicate a likelihood of eventual accreditation. Questions about eligibility and the accreditation process should be directed to the President of the Commission.

Institutional Evaluation Program

In September 2009, USEK completed the Institutional Evaluation Program conducted by the European Association of Universities (EUA) and became the first university in the Middle East to conduct such an evaluation program.



The Institutional Evaluation Programme (IEP) is an independent membership service of the European University Association (EUA), the representative organization of universities and national rectors' conferences in 47 European countries.

evalag European Institutional Accreditation 2012-2021

The European Institutional Accreditation was initially granted to USEK in December 2012 for a five-year period, and was renewed

for an additional five years in June 2017 by the Accreditation Commission of evalag.



evalag EVALUATIONSAGENTUR BADEN – WÜRTTEMBERG. evalag is an active member of ENQA (European Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education), EQAR (European Quality Assurance Register), CEENQA (Central and Eastern European Network of Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education), DeGEval (Gesellschaft für Evaluation e.V., German Evaluation Society), and INQAAHE (International Network for Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education).

MATRIX Accreditation for Student Support Services

USEK became the first university in Lebanon and the region to gain accreditation for its student support services, which aims to ensure its commitment to offer high quality services to its students for their welfare on campus, and ultimately for supporting them in their learning, career and life goals. The accreditation was initially obtained in July 2015. Two reaccreditation visits were successfully completed in July 2018 and July 2021, resulting in an accreditation renewal until July 2024.



The matrix standard is a unique quality standard established in the UK as a means for organizations to assess and measure their advice and support services, which ultimately sustain individuals in their choice of career, learning, work and life goals.

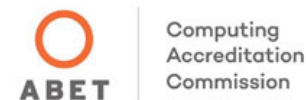

Architecture Program

The term "International Certification" identifies a program as comparable in educational outcomes in all significant aspects to a program accredited by the NAAB in the United States and indicates that it provides an educational experience meeting acceptable standards, even though such program may differ in format or method of delivery. The designation is valid for six years beginning 1 January of the year in which the final visit (Visit 3) took place. In order to maintain the designation, the program must be visited again in the sixth year of the designation.

Schools with programs identified as holding NAAB International Certification are not formally "accredited" as that term is used with reference to programs in the United States and may not refer to their programs as "accredited" by the NAAB. However, students who graduate from internationally certified programs are able to apply for individualized review of their credentials on an expedited basis for purposes of the Educational Evaluation Services for Architects program administered by the NAAB on behalf of the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards.



The Holy Spirit University of Kaslik, School of Architecture and Design has received the International Certification designation from the National Architectural Accrediting Board for the following professional degree program: Master of Architecture degree (193 semester credit hours) – 2019

French Equivalency of the Architecture Program

By decision of the French Minister of Culture on April 24, 2018, the Diploma of Master of Architecture awarded by USEK's School of Architecture and Design is recognized as being equivalent to the French Diploma in Architecture. This recognition was renewed on April 14, 2021, for a period of five years as of the academic year 2020-2021.

The French Diploma in Architecture allows its holder to practice as a salaried architect in France and offers the opportunity to enroll in the training course for "the training of the graduate architect to provide services in person". This training provides those who undergo it with the opportunity to be enrolled in the registry for exercising the profession as an independent architect.

In June 2017, eight Social Sciences and Humanities programs received the International Accreditation by the Accreditation Commission of evalag, EVALUATIONSAGENTUR BADEN-WÜRTTEMBERG <http://www.evalag.de>, known as a center of competence for quality assurance and enhancement and a source of support for higher education institutions and other scientific institutions, with commitment for good quality in teaching and learning, research and other services.

Medical Education

In 2019, the undergraduate medical education program offered by the school of medicine and medical sciences was granted full accreditation for six years, effective from January 2019 until December 2024, after being successfully evaluated by the Association for Evaluation and Accreditation of Medical Education Programs (tepdad).

This recent success follows the Basic Medical Education: World Federation for Medical Education (WFME) Global Standards for Quality Improvement awarded in 2015.



tepdad is recognized by the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME) and the Lebanese Ministry of Higher Education as an accrediting agency for medical education.

PRESIDENT

Reverend Father Talal Hachem, born in Hasbaya in 1970, graduated with a bachelor degree in Theology from the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik in 1998. In 2002 he obtained a bachelor degree in Law followed by a Master's degree in Canon Law in 2004, both from the University of Strasbourg in France. He completed his PhD in Canon Law in Ottawa, Canada in 2009 with a thesis in Oriental Law entitled "The juridical situation of the Maronite community in Montreal." In 2012, he decided to top-up his education with an MBA degree from HEC Montreal.

Father Hachem has held numerous positions on both the national and international levels. In Dakar, Senegal, he served as Director of School Notre Dame de Liban from 1998 until 1999. In Suresnes, France, he served as Director of the Arabic School and the Spiritual Center for the Lebanese Community from 1999 until 2000. Then, between 2004 and 2010, he was the Superior of the Monastery of Saint Anthony the Great in Montreal, Canada.

In 2010, he came back to Lebanon and served as Superior of the Monastery and Saint Antoine Hospital in Beit Chabab, Lebanon until 2013. Father Hachem has also held several key academic positions at USEK. In 2013, he was appointed Dean of the School of Law, then Vice President for Community Life in 2016. In 2019 he was appointed President of the University.

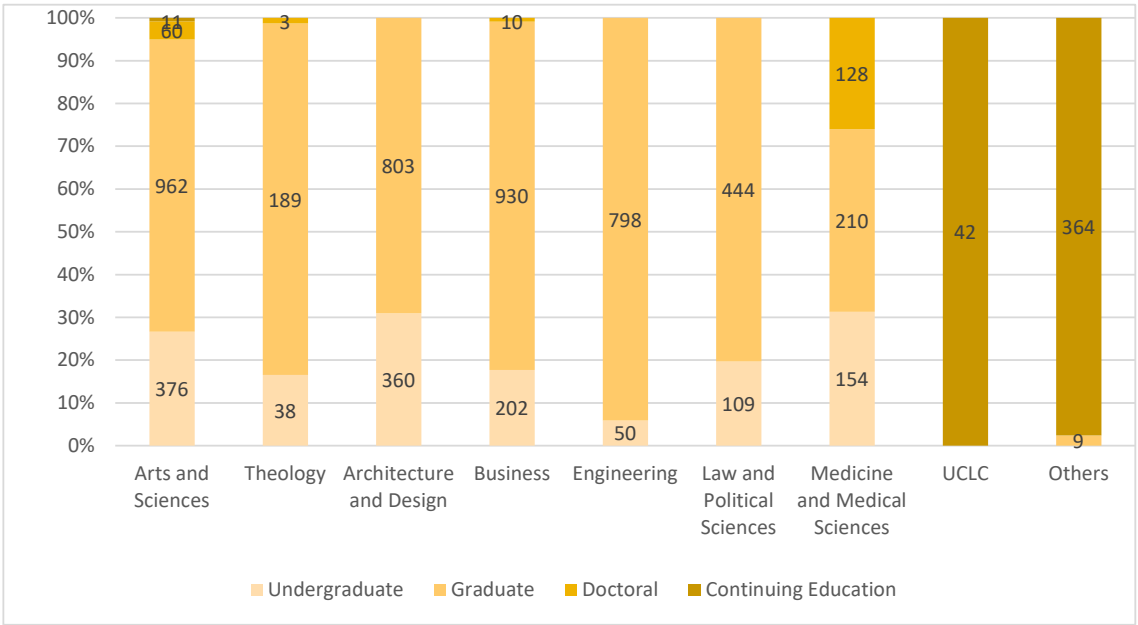

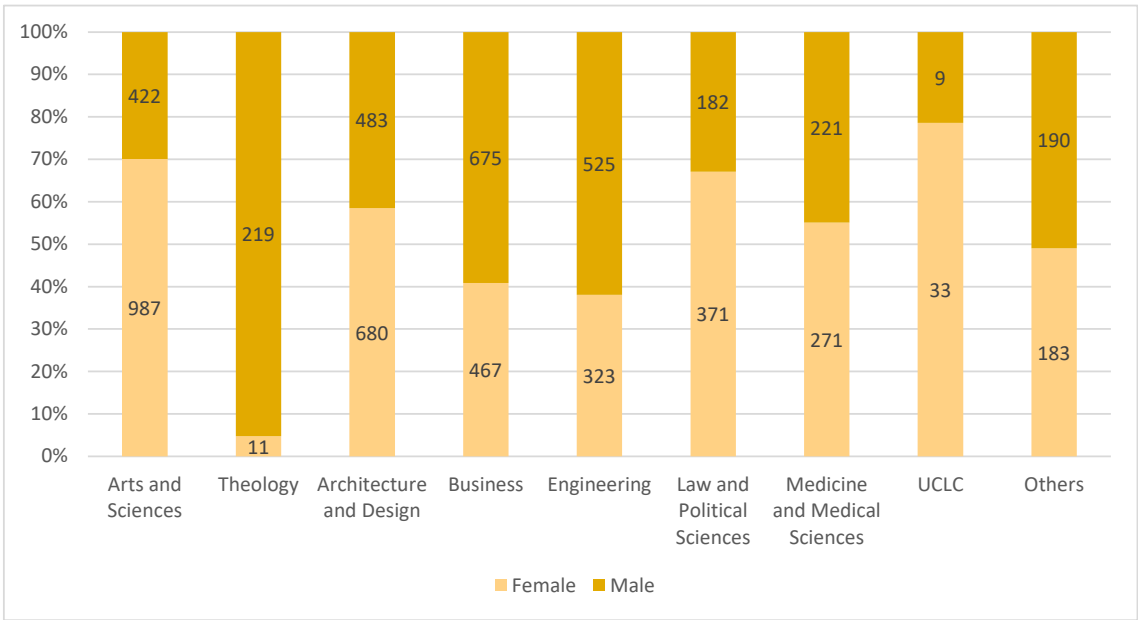

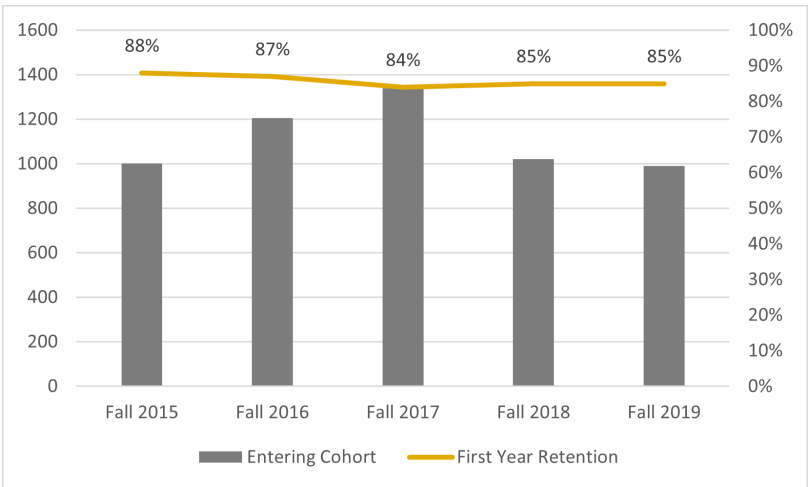

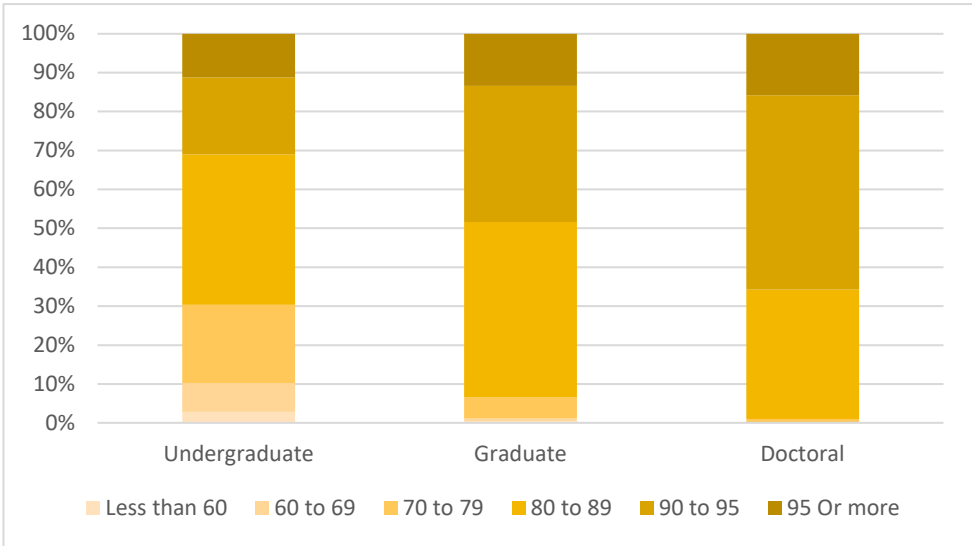

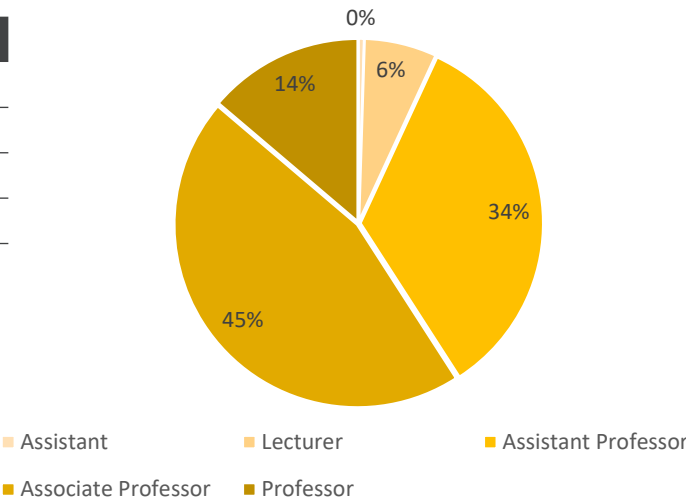

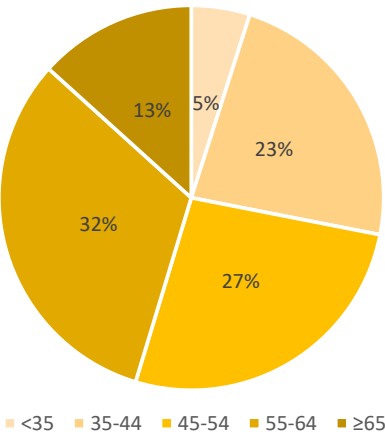

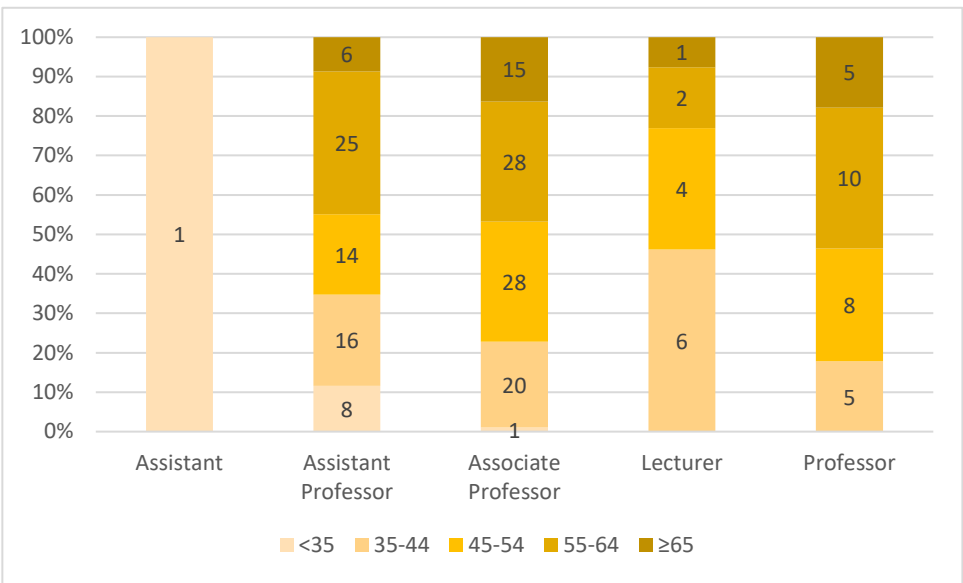


Full-time Faculty Members Age Distribution

USEK Library (<https://www.usek.edu.lb/library>) has upheld its academic support by preserving and conserving the Lebanese culture heritage in all its aspects (historical, religious, and philosophical) and formats (newspapers, manuscripts, rare books, archives, photographs, and maps etc.).

Researchers from Lebanon and abroad frequently visit the USEK Library for its rich yet historical collections particularly on Lebanon and the Middle East. The USEK library opens a total of 40 hours per week.

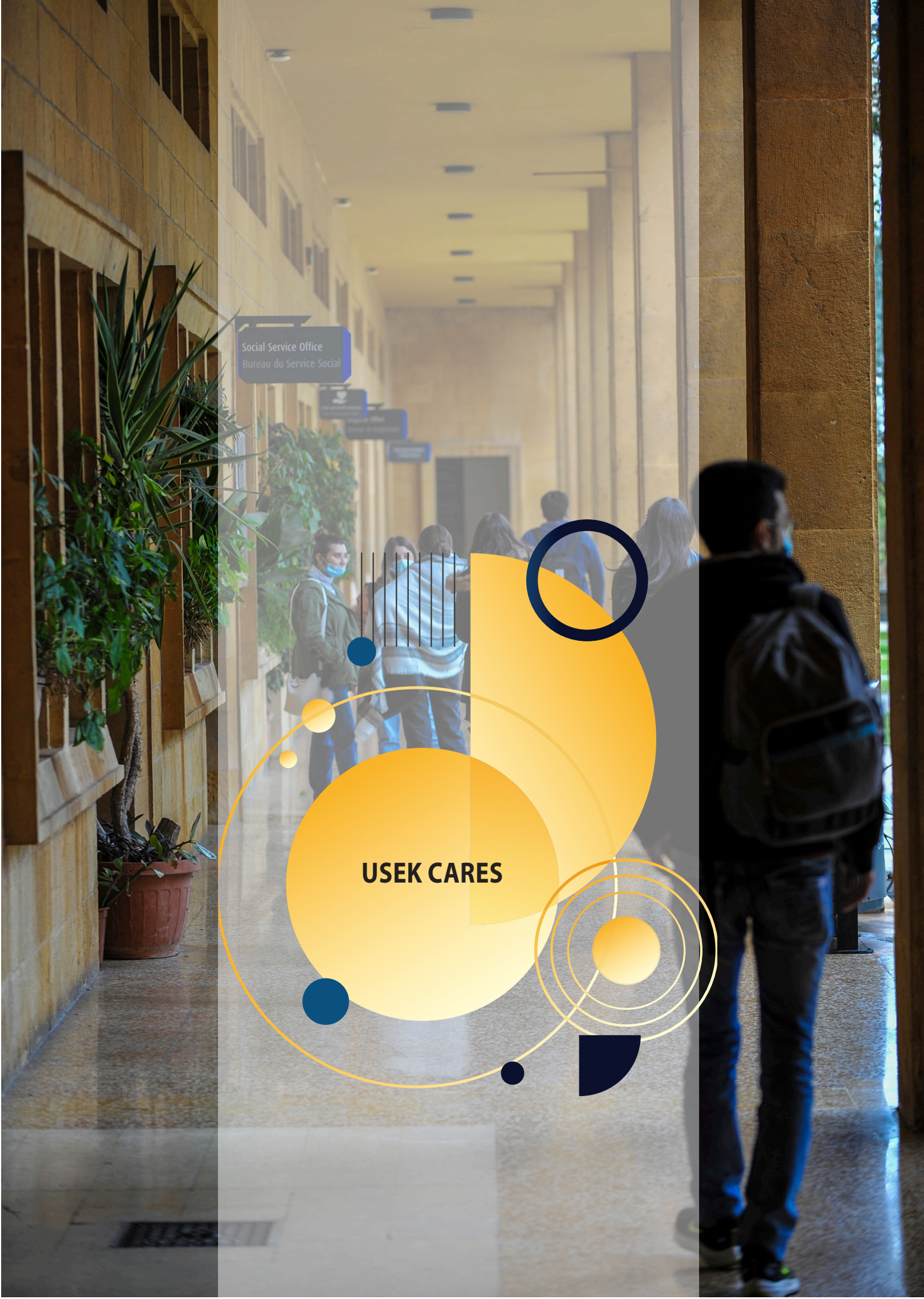

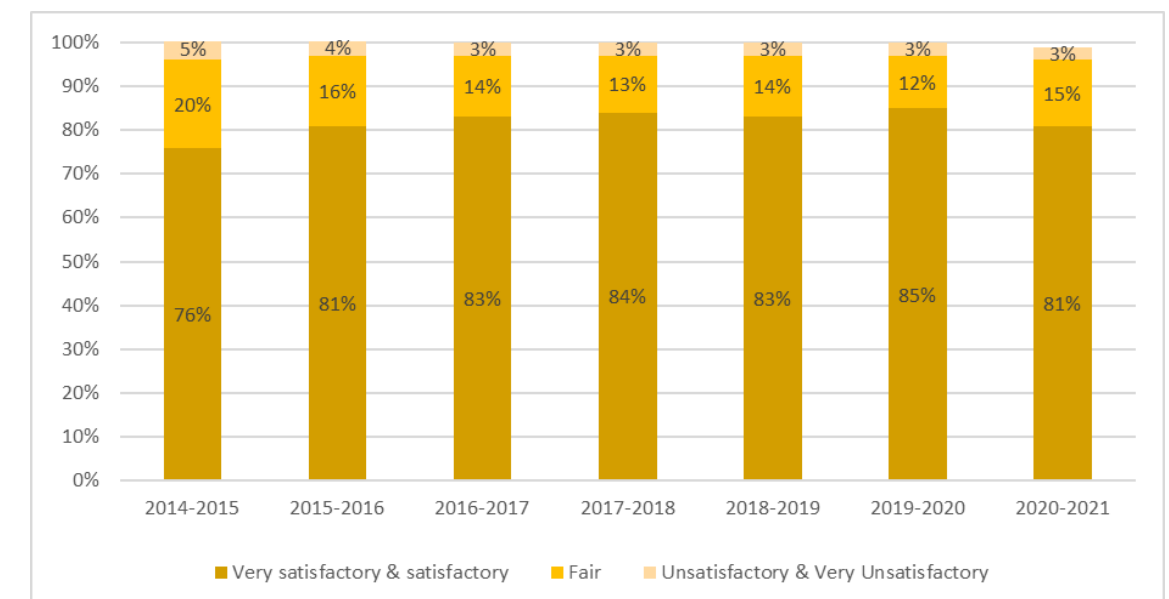
