Background


USEK was founded in 1938 as an independent private Catholic institution, by the


Lebanese Maronite Order (hereafter referred to as the "OLM") who have served higher education in monasteries since the 18th century. Preceding the first Lebanese Law of Higher Education, put into effect in 1961, USEK was officially certified as a private higher education institution under the new law in 1962. Since 1997, the University has adopted the North American credit system in a move toward an American-style institution to facilitate students' credit transfer and recognition locally and abroad.

Mission

Since its founding, USEK has sought to contribute to the development of all its students through quality educational programs and research in various fields of study. By providing a high-quality American-style education to its students, and in accordance with Article 92 of the Constitutions of the OLM (ed. 2012), and the social teaching of the Catholic Church in universities, USEK prepares future leaders for innovation, professional growth and life-long learning in Lebanon, within the Middle East, and throughout the world. USEK is committed to a faith-based educational development of its students rooted in the Catholic tradition whereby spiritual values and ethics as well as respect for cultural and religious pluralism are supported.





Academic Units

The University has recently restructured its academic units, replacing its twelve faculties and three institutes with one faculty and six schools. A new academic structure was implemented in fall, 2020.



Accreditations, Evaluations and Rankings

Institutional Evaluation Program

In September 2009, USEK completed the Institutional Evaluation Program conducted by the European Association of Universities (EUA) and became the first university in the Middle East to conduct such an evaluation program.



The Institutional Evaluation Programme (IEP) is an independent membership service of the European University Association (EUA), the representative organization of universities and national rectors' conferences in 47 European countries.

The European Institutional Accreditation was initially granted to USEK in December 2012 for a five-year period, and was renewed for an additional five years in June 2017 by the Accreditation Commission of evalag.

Architecture Program

The term "International Certification" identifies a program as comparable in educational outcomes in all significant aspects to a program accredited by the NAAB in the United States and indicates that it provides an educational experience meeting acceptable standards, even though such program may differ in format or method of delivery.



NAAB International Certification is valid for six years beginning 1 January of the year in which the final visit (Visit 3) took place. In order to maintain the designation, the program must be visited again in the sixth year of the designation.

Schools with programs identified as holding NAAB International Certification are not formally "accredited" as that term is used with reference to programs in the United States and may not refer to their programs as "accredited" by NAAB. However, students who graduate from internationally certified programs are able to apply for individualized review of their credentials on an expedited basis for purposes of the Educational Evaluation Services for Architects program administered by the NAAB on behalf of the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards.

The Holy Spirit University of Kaslik, School of Architecture and Design received the International Certification designation from the National Architectural Accrediting Board in 2019 for the following professional degree program: Master in Architecture degree (193 semester credit hours)

Medical Education

In 2019, the undergraduate medical education program offered by the school of medicine and medical sciences was granted full accreditation for six years, effective from January 2019 until December 2024, after being successfully evaluated by the Association for Evaluation and Accreditation of Medical Education Programs (TEPDAD).

This recent success follows the Basic Medical Education: World Federation for Medical Education (WFME) Global Standards for Quality Improvement awarded in 2015.



TEPDAD is recognized by the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME) and the Lebanese Ministry of Higher Education as an accrediting agency for medical education.





He completed his PhD in Canon Law in Ottawa, Canada in 2009 with a thesis in Oriental Law entitled "The juridical situation of the Maronite community in Montreal." In 2012, he decided to top-up his education with an MBA degree from HEC Montreal.


Father Hachem has held numerous positions on both the national and international levels. In Dakar, Senegal, he served as Director of School Notre Dame de Liban from 1998 until 1999. In Suresnes, France, he served as Director of the Arabic School and the Spiritual Center for the Lebanese Community from 1999 until 2000. Then, between 2004 and 2010, he was the Superior of the Monastery of Saint Anthony the Great in Montreal, Canada.

In 2010, he came back to Lebanon and served as Superior of the Monastery and Saint Antoine Hospital in Beit Chabab, Lebanon until 2013. Father Hachem has also held several key academic positions at USEK. In 2013, he was appointed Dean of the School of Law, then Vice President for Community Life in 2016. In 2019 he was appointed President of the University.







COVID-19

- WHAT IS IT -

Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is an infectious disease caused by a newly discovered coronavirus.

- SYMPTOMS -

COVID-19 affects different people in different ways. Most infected people will develop mild to moderate illness and recover without hospitalization.

fever - dry cough - tiredness - aches and pains - sore throat- diarrhoea conjunctivitis - headache - loss of taste or smell - difficulty breathing - chest pain or pressure - loss of speech or movement.



- TRANSMISSION -

The COVID-19 virus spreads primarily through droplets of saliva or discharge from the nose when an infected person coughs or sneezes, so it's important that you also practice respiratory etiquette.

- PREVENTION -

To prevent infection and to slow transmission of COVID-19, do the following:

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water, or clean them with alcohol-based hand rub.
- Maintain at least 1 metre distance between you and people coughing or sneezing.
- Avoid touching your face.
- -Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing.
- Stay home if you feel unwell.
- Refrain from smoking and other activities that weaken the lungs.






Applications and Admissions








Student map






Distribution of Full-time Faculty Members by Degree


Distribution of Full-time Faculty Members by Rank




Full-time Faculty Members Age Distribution




Full-time Faculty Members Age Distribution by Rank












Survey on Online Learning Experience - Spring 2020


