Scope and Content

Georges and Maroun Haimari Collection donated 2016 by Joseph Haimari, is a voluminous compilation of political and historical archives, transmitted from Georges Haimari to his son Maroun Haimari, Directors General of the Lebanese Presidency. The Collection consists mostly of 300 colored and, black and white photos of various Lebanese historical and political events, and photos of prominent Lebanese politicians, religious and social figures, as well as Arab and foreign world leaders' figures. These photos, taken in Lebanon, Arab and Western countries span the years 1918-2014, with the bulk of the material concentrated in the period 1926-2014. Also included in the collection a little material of press clippings.

These materials retrace the history of Lebanon, highlight Lebanon's diplomatic life, and represent hence a rich source of information for scholars and researchers interested in Lebanese history and politics, among others.
