## Scholarship Terms and Conditions:

- 1. The scholarship does not cover the registration fees to be paid per semester or the annual fees of accession to the National Social Security Fund.
- 2. The Protocol Scholarship is valid only for the program chosen by the candidate (as per the online confirmation process) and is offered only during the Fall semester.
- 3. The Protocol scholarship will take effect only if the candidate registers directly in the offered Fall semester.
- 4. The scholarship does not cover the summer session.
- 5. The scholarship holder should undertake a full-time schedule: a minimum of 12 credits and a maximum of 18 credits for undergraduate studies.
- 6. The Scholarship of Protocol is conditioned by the results of an audit carried out at the end of each semester since the first academic year.
- 7. The beneficiary of a scholarship will lose his/her scholarship privileges in the following cases:
  - If the student's grade average falls below 88/100.
  - If the student is placed on academic probation.
  - If the student did not register as a full-timer (between 12 and 18 credits).
  - If the student performs a change of program after the first semester.
  - If the student voluntarily interrupts studies.
  - If the student withdraws from one or more courses.
  - If the student proceeds with a term withdrawal.
  - If the student fails one or more courses.
  - If the student is subject to disciplinary action due to less than exemplary behavior If the student does not respect University rules and regulations.
- 8. The student can regain the scholarship privileges if he/she succeeds to increase his GPA as per the requirements.
- 9. If the student fails to maintain the scholarship, he/she has the right to submit a social file at the Financial Aid Office (fao@usek.edu.lb).
