 - o a minimum of 6 credits and a maximum of 10 credits for graduate studies.
- 3. The maintaining of the scholarship is subject to the coach reports and recommendations, to the candidate's academic situation, and the assessment of the head of the sports department and the director of SAO.
- 4. The maintaining of the scholarship is subject to the student's engagement and commitment to training and department's activities (such as but not limited to camps, workshops, conferences, etc.). If the student fails to show commitment, he/she shall sign a first warning after which he/she shall be suspended from the team.
- 5. Maintaining the Sport Scholarship is conditioned by an audit carried out at the end of each term. The beneficiary of a scholarship will forfeit his/her scholarship privileges in the following cases:
 - If the student is placed on academic probation (student's cumulative GPA falls below 70/100 for undergraduate students or below 80/100 for School of medicine and medical sciences students and graduate students);
 - If the student fails one or more courses;
 - o If the student withdraws from one or more courses;
 - If the student proceeds with a term withdrawal;
 - If the student voluntarily interrupts studies;
 - o If the student does not show his/her ultimate commitment toward USEK's team (trainings, games, tournaments, travel, etc.) due to his/her club's obligations;
 - Upon decision of the Disciplinary Board, if the student does not sustain an exemplary behavior;
 - If the student does not respect University rules and regulations.
